

Antiques Roadshow at Holker Hall

The BBC filmed an edition of the Antiques Roadshow at Holker Hall in July 2016 which was broadcast on 25 June 2017.

Roadshow regular Adam Schoon visited Hill Top and invited Janine to take along our first edition of *The House at Pooh Corner* signed by AA Milne, and her piece with book expert Clive Farahar was used in the programme. (We have a large collection of signed editions!)

We used to live in Tunbridge Wells, Kent. Only a few miles away in East Sussex was the small village of Hartfield where Milne once lived at Cotchford Farm (and which was later bought by Brian Jones of the Rolling Stones). Nearby, in the Ashdown Forest, is "Pooh Bridge", which we occasionally visited with our daughter when she was young.
